Vintage

The warm spring and summer created one of the earliest harvest in Oregon history. We began picking September 12th and soon realized we had an outstanding harvest on our hands. Perfect September weather gifted us exceptional fruit picked at its peak.

Winemaking

Lot sorted, small batch, temperature controlled fermentation. Expertly blended before gentle

Aging

18 months in 100% French oak. 20% new. 20% one year, and 60% 2 year old or neutral barrels. 18 months in bottle

Tasting Notes

To the eye the wine presents a bright ruby hue with luminous highlights. the bouquet is composted of violets, with fruit notes from strawbeny's and rhubarb while there is an undertone of subtle spice. Unusually bright with fantastic texture it lines the pallet with silk and lace. Pleasing tart cherry, a hint of pie spice, and dusty tannins lead to a long complex finish.
